

GLA Employee Benefits

- membership in the Local Government Pension Scheme (LGPS) a defined benefit pension scheme, providing a secure, index-linked future income, independent of share prices and stock market fluctuations.
- 30 days annual leave (in addition to statutory public holidays), pro rata for part-time.
- a range of flexible working arrangements allowing staff to balance work and home commitments, including a flexible hours scheme, job-sharing and remote working.
- generous maternity leave, as well as birth/adoption support leave, shared parental leave, ordinary parental leave (up to 13 weeks unpaid leave for children under 5 upon completion of one year's service) and carers and dependency leave.
- access to up to 12 months unpaid sabbatical leave after one year's service.
- three days per year of volunteering leave per year.
- access to myGLA+ the GLA's discounts and benefits portal, providing discounts or cashback across hundreds of retailers online and in-store from supermarkets, gym memberships, travel, fashion, entertainment, home utilities or days out.
- a range of interest-free loans season ticket, childcare fees, tenancy deposit, gym membership, bicycle purchase and visa-related costs.
- salary sacrifice schemes for cycle to work and paying for additional voluntary contributions (AVCs) as part of your LGPS membership.
- access to join Benenden Health via their corporate membership, providing private healthcare for £15.50 per month through payroll deductions.
- annual leave trade-in of up to two days per year.
- free health screening and mammograms (subject to eligibility criteria).
- contributions towards eye tests, glasses and flu job costs.
- allowance for home-working equipment to support flexible working (claimed via expenses).
